

**THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF BURK'S FALLS**

**BY-LAW : 16-2007**

**Being a by-law to prohibit the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality without authority from the owner or occupant of such property.**

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Act S. O. 2001, c.25 as amended 2007 Section 127(1) gives authority to Councils to prohibit littering on private or municipal property; and

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Village of Burk's Falls deems it expedient to prohibit the dumping of refuse outside the limits of the land fill site on Village property and for imposing a fine against any person who contravenes this by-law:

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council for the Village of Burk's Falls enacts as follows:

The Council for the Village of Burk's Falls prohibits the throwing/placing or depositing refuse or debris on private property or on the property of the municipality without the authority of the owner or occupants of such property, save and except for those areas designated by the Corporation of the Village of Burk's Falls, by by-law as dump or land fill site.

**That** any person contravening the provisions of this by-law shall be liable to prosecution. Except where otherwise expressly provided by law, every person who is convicted of an offence is liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000. R.S.O. 1990, c. P.33, s. 61. provided for under the Provincial Offences Act.

**That** this by-law shall be enforced by the By-law Enforcement Officer for the Village of Burk's Falls or any persons so designated to enforce this by-law.


**That** this by-law shall come into effect on the date it is passed by the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Burk's Falls.
