**By-Law NO. 18 – 2006**

**BEING A BY-LAW PROHIBIT MOTORIZED  
SNOW VEHICLES FROM MUNICIPAL SIDEWALKS  
THE VILLAGE OF BURK'S FALLS**

**WHEREAS** S.7 of the Motorized Snow Vehicles Act, C.M. 44, R.S.O. 1990 provides that by-laws may be passed by the Council of a local municipality regulating governing or prohibiting the operation of motorized snow vehicles within the Municipality including any highways therein or on part or parts thereof.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Burk's Falls enacts as follows:

1. Definitions for the purposes of the By-law:  
**"Sidewalk"** -means any municipality winter-maintained sidewalk, pathway, footpath, area forming part of any highway or bridge or boulevard or other means of public communication made available, used by, set apart or designated for the use of pedestrians on highways under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the Village of Burk's Falls.
2. a) No person shall drive or operate a motorized snow vehicle within the meaning of the Motorized Snow Vehicles Act, R.S.O. 1990 and its regulations, along any sidewalk or part of a sidewalk, or any pedestrian footbridge within and under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the Village of Burk's Falls.  
b) Section 2.a) shall not apply to motorized snow vehicles operated by ambulance, police and fire departments while engaged in performing their duties or employees of the Village of Burk's Falls actually engaged in work or services undertaken for or on behalf of the respective operations  
c) Section 2.a) shall not apply to any person who shall drive or operate a motorized snow vehicle across a sidewalk as may be required to gain access to a trail, highway, service roadway, private property, public facility or commercial enterprise.  
d) No person shall drive a motorized snow vehicle across a sidewalk except at an angle of approximately 90 degrees to the direction of the said sidewalk.  
e) Every person who contravenes the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as set out in the Set Fines Schedule (Appendix A) attached to and forming part of this by-law.
