

CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF BURK'S FALLS

BY-LAW NO. 17-2020

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE CARE AND CONTROL OF ANIMALS BYLAW 8-2017 TO PROHIBIT CATS FROM RUNNING AT LARGE

WHEREAS sections 8, 9 and 10 of the Municipal Act, 2001, R.S.O. authorize the Village of Burk's Falls to pass by-laws necessary or desirable for municipal purposes, and in particular paragraphs 5, 8 and 9 of subsection 10(2) authorize by-laws respecting: the economic, social and environmental well-being of the municipality; the protection of persons and property; and animals; and

AND WHEREAS subsection 8(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, R.S.O provides that a by-law under section 10 of that Act respecting a matter may regulate or prohibit an activity.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Burk's Falls hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Care and Control General Provisions section of Bylaw 8-2017 be amended to include cats

CARE AND CONTROL GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1.1 Every person who keeps a dog and/or cat within the Village shall ensure that such animal is provided with:
- a) a clean and sanitary environment free from an accumulation of fecal matter;
 - b) adequate and appropriate care, food, water, shelter, shade and opportunity for


2. That the Responsibilities of the Owner section be amended to include cats:

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE OWNER:


- No owner of a dog and/or cat shall permit it to run at large in the Village of Burk's Falls.
- No owner shall allow a dog and/or cat, whether leashed or unleashed to trespass on private property.
- No owner shall allow their dog and/or cat to be on a public road or in a public place at any time unless the dog/cat is on a leash and such leash is held onto by a person.
- Notwithstanding section 4.3 no person shall allow a dog and/or cat to be at large at any time in any area designated as a public park or trail.
- Every owner of a dog and/or cat shall forthwith clean up and dispose of any excrement left by their dog/cat on any property other than their own. This section 4.5 does not apply to owners of registered handicap assist dogs.
