In consideration of permission, granted now or in the future by the Village of Burk's Falls (The Village) to participate in

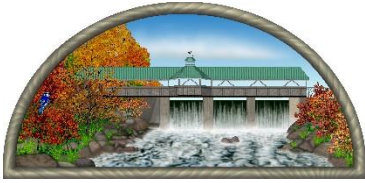
Trail Walks (The Event) on _____, 20____, I agree and acknowledge that:

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Burk's Falls Recreation Programs COVID-19 Policies and Procedures

Overview

The Village of Burk's Falls goal is to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 by following the guidelines from the North Bay Parry Sound District Health Unit and the Province of Ontario. Our staff, volunteers and participants health and safety are important to us as we work together to prevent the transmission of COVID-19.

Purpose

To ensure the health and safety of the Village of Burk's Falls Municipal staff, volunteers, and program participants, while attending our facilities and programs. All outlined procedures will remain in effect for the entire duration of the program you are participating in.

Scope

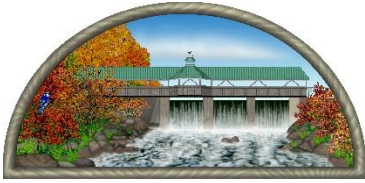
This policy must be followed by all staff, volunteers, and participants of recreation programs to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

Safety Measures

- Face coverings to be worn upon entrance to the facility unless exempt for a personal/medical reason
- Hand sanitization stations will be set up just inside the arena doors (participants must sanitize upon entrance to the facility)
- Participants are required to continue wearing a face covering unless engaging in an activity in which case they must maintain a physical distance of 2m/6ft
- All participants must supply their own water
- A designated entrance and exit to the facility will be in place to allow the 2nd group to enter the facility without meeting the 1st group
- No spectators allowed
- No prolonged contact will be permitted
- All equipment will be sanitized by staff in between programs
- Participants will be allowed into the building 15 minutes prior to their program and must exit the building no more than 15 minutes after the program
- Stay home if you are sick
- Avoid touching your face, eyes, nose, and mouth to prevent infection

Procedures

- Face coverings to be worn upon entrance to the facility unless exempt for a personal/medical reason
- Participants must use the hand sanitizer stations placed just inside the main entrances
- All participants must fill out a screening page prior to participation
- Participants are asked to follow the directions to properly enter and exit the facility
- Physical distancing is required at all times (2m/6ft)
- All participants must wash and sanitize their hands after using the washroom and if you cough/sneeze into your hands/blow your nose
- Cough and sneeze into your elbow



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Staff Policy

- Responsible for enforcing all Recreation Program Policies and Procedures
- Must wear a face covering when interacting with the public and other staff members if a physical distance of 2m/6ft cannot be maintained
- Must follow all guidelines laid out by the North Bay Parry Sound District Health Unit
- Clean commonly touched surfaces and disinfect equipment in between uses and as needed
- Educate participants on cleaning equipment during the program if required
- Staff will not attend the program if they are ill, another staff will fill in
- Must always keep a physical distance of (2m/6ft) distance from all volunteers and participants even while instructing
- Your will not be permitted if you show signs or symptoms of COVID-19 and will be asked to leave should staff see any signs or symptoms of an illness

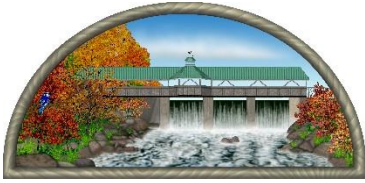

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Additional Policy and Procedures listed by specific program;

Trail Walks

- Must wear a face covering if you cannot maintain a physical distance of 2m/6ft

Pickleball/Badminton

- Members of the same household can be doubles partners without a face covering, all other participants must wear a face covering while playing doubles
- If participants play singles, they do not need a face covering
- Should players switch courts the ball/shuttlecock must be sanitized

Archery

- Every shooter must sanitize the bow and arrows between rounds
- One parent per registered child under the age of 18 may attend

Indoor Walking/Strollercise

- Toddlers in or out of stroller must maintain a physical distance of 2m/6ft from all participants
- All participants must wear a face covering at all times

Ball Hockey

- Sharing equipment is not permitted
- Pinnies will be assigned to each player
- 4 on 4 play with goalie, only 3 allowed on the bench at one time = 16 total participants
- One parent per registered child under the age of 18 must sit in the designated seating area
- No faceoffs
- No players allowed in the goalie key
- No prolonged contact will be permitted the play will be stopped
- Game ejections will occur if players don't respect and follow protocols (3 warnings)
- No more than two players battling along the boards
- Wipe down balls between games and if they go out of play
- All penalties will result in a penalty shot
